**CLASSIFICATIONS:** (Non-Judged) No awards; (PRO) Professional: working diligently at marketing his or her artwork; sells frequently, often wins show awards and/or teaches (ADV) Advanced: skills improving; some sales; enters local shows and starting to win awards (AMA) Amateur: beginner; yet to win first prize in this class (judge has discretion to change an artist's classification).

**ENTRY FEES:** MEMBERS; one entry \$25, two entries \$30 (includes non-judged)  
NON-MEMBERS; one entry \$35, two entries \$40 (includes non-judged)  
Small Wall: \$5 for one 5x7 (or smaller); Bargain Bin: \$10 for up to 5 unframed works

**LEGACY RIBBONS:** The legacy ribbon (\$50 with proceeds to be split 50/50 between the club and the artist - email Linda Dembitsky @ [alcoveoffice@gmail.com](mailto:alcoveoffice@gmail.com) for more information) gives everyone a chance to judge the show and award your own ribbon. Please print the name you would like on the ribbon on the entry form below. **Legacy ribbon postmark deadline is September 23, 2020.**

**SMALL WALL:** Show and sell one (1) small piece (5x7 or less, framed and ready to hang). Not judged, small wall pieces are not part of the show and should be priced \$125 or less. Commission rates apply.

**BARGAIN BIN:** Bargain Bin pieces are not "exhibits." They may be unframed, but should be protected and ready for sale (under \$100 please).

**ELIGIBILITY:** Two-dimensional art must be original in concept and execution, less than two years old, and not shown previously at the art center. Unacceptable entries include: photographs, painted or colored photographs, digitally enhanced images, workshop creations, and pieces previously shown in a B&P show. Exhibits must be gallery framed or gallery wrapped and wire hung. NO saw-tooth hangers. Artwork should be no wider than 48" and any height. Show is limited to 120 pieces (with case by case exceptions - email Linda Dembitsky @ [alcoveoffice@gmail.com](mailto:alcoveoffice@gmail.com) for information). Member pieces have priority. Please note that photos of artwork may be used by B&P for advertising.

**AWARDS:** Best of Show: \$300; Professional: \$150, \$120, \$90, \$25; Advanced: \$120, \$90, \$60, \$25; Amateur \$90, \$60, \$30, \$25.

**SALES AND INSURANCE:** the art center receives a 20% commission and the GJ Brush and Palette Club receives a 10% commission (work need not be for sale). B&P will pay artists for sold works by the 15th of January. Delivery of entries to the art center automatically waives any claim for damages or loss against the GJ Brush and Palette Club or the Art Center. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist. Please arrange to have artwork picked up on time.
